Environmental Policy

- Take the necessary actions to prevent pollution to the air, land and water and responsibly manage historic environmental impacts.

Resources, roles, responsibility and authority

Roles, responsibilities and authorities shall be defined, documented and communicated to facilitate effective environmental management by:

- Ensuring an environmental management practice is established, implemented and maintained in compliance with the Environmental Protection Agency.
- Frequently review our environmental system for improvements.
- Their roles and responsibilities in achieving consistency with the requirements of the environmental management system

Competence, Training and awareness

Thorpe shall establish, implement and maintain a procedure to make personnel working for or on its behalf aware of:

- The importance of consistency with the environmental policy and procedures and with the requirements of the environmental management system.
- The significant environmental aspects and impacts associated with their work and the environmental benefits of improved personal performance to minimize waste.

Environmental Hazard Assessment

Management shall define Thorpe's environmental policy and ensure compliance within the defined scope of its environmental management system:

- Appropriate to the nature, scale and risk of environmental impact of its activities, products and services.
- Commitment to continually improve and prevent pollution.
- Commitment to comply with applicable legal requirements and with other requirements to which the organization subscribes relating to its environmental aspects.
- Provide the framework for setting and reviewing environmental objectives and targets.
- Ensure communication to all personnel working on behalf of Thorpe Specialty Services Inc.
